- Maintain a minimum
2.0 GPA for undergraduates or
3.0 GPA for graduate students

PRIORITY CONSIDERATION WILL BE GIVEN TO:

- Non-traditional students (including
student parents)
- First-generation college students
- Science, Technology, Engineering, and
Mathematics (STEM) majors and
- STEM Education / Teaching majors
