1. Who makes the Access Control System?

Security Pacific is the vendor and IDenticard is the manufacturer. OHA HR manages the access control system.

2. Do we need a class "B" (General Building) Contractor's License?

No.

3. Who is the contact person for the Security Pacific?

4. Would you like to stick with the new aluminum model, push bar?

Yes.

5. Will it be a total of 12 push bars?

Yes, 11 for Install and 1 for Spare

6. Do we need a building permit?

7. What is the timeframe to complete the work?

We are being proactive about getting the push bars replaced, so this is not an emergency. The estimated contract start date would be October 2023.
