

MĀLAMA HONUA DISASTER FUND

Grants Program

The Mālama Honua Disaster Fund (MHDF) Program provides \$10,000 habitability repair grants for Native Hawaiian homeowners in identified areas that were highly impacted by the March 2026 Kona Low storms who experienced *minor damage* to their homes (the residence has non-structural damage and needs repair but is currently safe to live in).

*****The program is open to OHA beneficiary homeowners not otherwise eligible for OHA March 2026 Kona Low General Disaster Assistance Program funding facilitated by Hawaiian Council. *****

Eligibility

- Native Hawaiian (HRP verification required)
- Owner of the impacted principal residence
- Impacted residence was your principal residence during the Kona Low storms
- Impacted residence is located within an OHA-identified area that was highly impacted by the Kona Low storms
- Impacted residence experienced minor damage due to the Kona Low storms
- Provide verifiable quotes, invoices, or other cost documentation acceptable to OHA for Kona Low storm-related home repair or cleanup costs
- Submit a current, complete, and accurate W-9 form

Required Documents

- ✓ Photo ID & Hawaiian Registry Program Number
- ✓ Proof of homeownership & Principal residency
- ✓ Proof of Kona Low storm-related damage to residence
- ✓ Habitability Repair Scope & Cost Documentation from a Reputable Contractor/Business
- ✓ IRS Form W-9
