- 15. Q: What collection attempts are made prior to placement with a collection agency?
  - A: Previous attempts via third-party service provider prior to legal action (judgment).
- 16. Q: Please note that in 2016 the Attorneys General of 32 states entered into compliance agreements with all three major consumer credit reporting agencies ("credit bureaus"), which prohibit reporting any debt that did not arise from a contract or agreement to pay. All private collection agencies are required to comply with this change, and the credit bureaus will not accept reporting of non-consensual debt obligations. Contractor agrees to adhere to the requirements outlined in the RFP as permitted by law, but in general, most government receivables cannot be credit reported. Is this acceptable?
  - A: Yes, please report as permitted by law.
- 17. Q: What results, metrics, and/or processes are you seeking to improve or enhance under this contract?
  - A: Collection of the delinquency, whole or in part, is desired.
- 18. Q: Have all cases been fully adjudicated by the time of placement?
  - A: Yes.
