Quotes must be emailed to geenac@oha.org by 2:00 p.m. Hawai'i Standard Time on Friday, July 9, 2021. Please include all fees, delivery, and tax in the quote total.

Pursuant to Hawai'i Administrative Rules §3-122-75, considering the criteria, including but not limited to quality, warranty, and delivery; the award shall be made to the lowest most responsive, responsible offeror. When the award to the lowest responsive, responsible offeror is not practicable, the award shall be made to the offeror whose quotation provides the best value to the OHA.

The OHA reserves the right to reject any or all quotes and to accept the quotes in whole or part in the best interest of the OHA.

Printing Requirements

The successful Offeror shall provide and perform the services required in a satisfactory and proper manner as determined by the OHA. The services shall include, but may not be limited to, the following:

1. Print a quantity of 500 copies of the Mai Ka Po Mai document;
2. Main component OHA: 4pp Cvr;
3. Cover: Eighty pound (80#) Pacesetter Matte Cover or similar made from recyclable materials;
4. Text: Eighty pound (80#) Pacesetter Matte Book or similar made from recyclable materials;
5. Double-sided print with Four Color process inks to include bleeds;
6. Flat Size: 17 X 11, Final Size: 8.5 X 11, Half-fold;

7. Inks: 4/4: HP 4color / HP 4color;
8. 48 pages;
9. Saddle stitch or stitching type to be recommended by the Offeror based on paper stock and weight;
10. Standard packing; and
11. Local delivery to the OHA office located at 560 N. Nimitz Hwy, Suite 200, Honolulu, HI 96817 by Monday, August 2, 2021.
